

11. Term Discovery Form Instructions

- ① Enter the terms that you selected in Form 10: Term Relationship Form as A, B, and C. You will find deep connections between these terms. For these three terms connect each group of two: A and B, B and A, B and C, C and B, C and A, A and C. For each of these groups you will do the same thing. We will proceed with group A & B in this explanation.
- ② Without considering the meaning, enter term A and term B into the blanks.
- ③ If the sentence you make in step ② expresses your felt sense, ask yourself what kind of things you can conclude from it. You can also take notes whatever comes to your mind. Come up with hypotheses that you can deduce logically, and ask yourself whether they fit your felt sense; if not ask yourself why they do not fit.
- ④ While writing down things coming up with your mind, you will wait for the words that you feel is important to naturally come to your mind. If it comes to your mind, these words will be new terms and finish this step. These words/phrases should be nouns; if not, write in parentheses the corresponding noun(s).
- ⑤ Without considering the meaning, enter term A and term B into the blanks.
- ⑥ If the sentence you make in step ⑤ expresses your felt sense, ask yourself what kind of things you can conclude from it. You can also take notes whatever comes to your mind. Come up with hypotheses that you can deduce logically, and ask yourself whether they fit your felt sense; if not ask yourself why they do not fit. You can continue freely without considering the connection between A and B.
- ⑦ Do the same with the remaining groups.
