

2. Actual Case Form(2) Instructions

- ① Write down your theme. You can change words of words of theme later.
- ② Write down one scene that can recall practical experiences considered as your theme and assign numbers. You can leave some margin in the frame of form. This process aims at harking up / reviewing, and it is not necessary to make complete sentence. Also, you do not need to write down so that others can understand when they read. From one activity, you can extract various numbers of things /cases. After writing down enough amount of words, you can finish this process by putting 「.,.,」 to end of the word. These dots mean you cannot write anymore. When you work and share with partner or groups of others, you do not need to write proper noun. Use initials so that you can find something when you look back.
- ③ Underline some parts you think are important/significant after writing down.
- ④ Print a number of forms if not enough.
- ⑤ Make some copies of completed Actual Case Form and save them.
